Persevere! Being an author is really competitive. Rejections are part of the norm if you follow the traditional publishing route, and if you choose to self-publish, you will need to wear many hats and be effective in them all.

2. What are the steps a young person should take to go into this career?

There is no particular pathway you must follow, but it could help to have an English degree or have done a few creative writing courses. It's really important to read widely, even outside your favourite genres so that you can understand story structure.

I love the creativity. I love that I can work any hour of the day or night and there are no set rules. There is no "right" way to be a writer or to write a book, and it give you the freedom to explore books however you want.
